Craft Class - An Exhibit in the form of a swag

Space Allowed: Width 80cm, Depth 20cm, Height 100cm.

Exhibit to hang against a plain background and photographed from the front. Artificial plant material may be used.
(A swag is an exhibit designed to hang against a surface. All components are assembled without a visible background.)

Space Allowed: Width 80cm, Depth 70cm, Height 106cm.

To be staged against a plain background and photographed from the front. (Artificial plant material may be used.)

Space Allowed: Width 80cm, Depth 70cm, Height 106cm.

To be staged against a plain background and photographed from the front. (Artificial plant material may be used.)

✿ CLASS 4 "SEASONAL SPLENDOUR"

An Exhibit

Space Allowed: Width 80cm, Depth 70cm, Height 106cm.

To be staged against a plain background and photographed from the front. (Artificial plant material may be used.)

✿ CLASS 5 "MAGIC MOMENT"

OPEN

A Petite Exhibit

Space Allowed: Width 25cm, Depth 25cm, Height 37cm.

To be staged against a plain background and photographed from the front. (Artificial plant material may be used.)

REGULATIONS

1. Exhibits to be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual Third Edition 2015
2. Judges for the show are Mary O'Brien, NAFAS National Judge & Una Fleming, A.O.I.F.A.
3. (a) Novice – An exhibitor who has not won a first prize at a major show.
A Novice may also enter an Open Class.
(b) Those holding an AOIFA qualification are ineligible to enter the Novice Class.
4. **All exhibits must be the unaided work of the competitor.**
5. Online Entries will open on **Saturday 5th December 2020.**
Closing date for entries Thursday 10th December 2020.

Note: Competitors may enter as many classes as they wish but may not stage more than one entry per class.

STAGING & RESULTS

Enter class by logging on to the Munster Agricultural Society Website. Pick your class under Floral Art and you will be asked to attach the photograph. Only one photograph of your exhibit is required.

A 30cm ruler is to be included in the photograph.

- In the event of a Pavé or Tapestry please submit an aerial photograph.
- Each competitor's exhibit will be allocated a number and forwarded to the Judges.
- Results will be announced weekend of the 18th December (we will keep the A.O.I.F.A. social media updated)
- Entry fee €5
- Electronic Certificates will be awarded.
